Notes for prospective and renewing members: -

Any numbered frequencies are permitted on 35MHz FM. The club has also fully adopted 2.4 GHz FM. Only **solid** colours on 27MHz (No split frequencies permitted)

Large models (> 7 Kg) must comply with CAA and BMFA requirements and meet with the approval of the committee.

All new members who do not have a BMFA Certificate of Achievement will be required to join the Club's Training Scheme.

All new members who do not have a BMFA Certificate of Achievement are expected to attempt the BMFA "A" Certificate of Achievement within their first year of membership.

All new members who do not have a BMFA Certificate of Achievement will not be permitted to fly unless supervised by a Club Instructor. All new members who possess a BMFA Certificate of Achievement will be required to demonstrate their flying competence to the Club Training Officer before being allowed to fly solo at a Club field.

Prospective members may fly only after payment of their subscription.

Helicopter flyers wishing to join must have previously achieved a BMFA "A" helicopter competence certificate before joining the A&DMFC Members must have their peg on the pegboard at ALL times when flying. You must use an official club peg – no facsimiles permitted.

Please forward a copy of your BMFA membership certificate with your application if purchased separately.

Note- A fixed wing "A" certificate does not entitle a member to fly a helicopter at Folly Farm and vice versa, unsupervised.

This club does not undertake to supervise junior members other than for the actual act of model aircraft flying and associated pre and post flight procedures. At no time should your child be unsupervised by you or the nominated guardian while at a club flying field including during pre-flight preparations, during the actual flying sessions and post flights.

Our activities at the Club's flying sites do not finish at a regular times and it is therefore your responsibility to ensure the well-being of your child over and above arranging a predetermined collection time.

Should you wish to leave your child at the flying site, it is your responsibility to arrange for a responsible adult to supervise him/her during your absence.

The club does not undertake to accept responsibility for your child's supervision other than as described above and you are required to countersign this membership application form before your child's junior membership application will be accepted.
